Labour and Industry Act 1953.

TO DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

I, Henry Norman Jones, Secretary for Labour and Industry, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Labour and Industry Act, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February,

Adult employees whose usual hours of duty extend over six days per week shall receive in addition to their usual weekly wage prescribed in this Determination an additional 11s. 6d. per week; provided that improvers whose hours of duty are similarly extended shall receive pro rata the additional amount prescribed herein for adults.

* An additional amount of 20s. per week shall be paid to all employees provided-

(i) that this amount shall not be paid to any employee who absents himself from work without reasonable excuse on any day he is so required to work; and

(ii) sub-clause (i) hereof shall not apply to the rostered day off or to an employee who is absent on sick leave
