Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 264s. 9d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force provided that in clause 15 the amount of 117s. 6d. wherever appearing shall be increased to 166s. 9d.
