#### DETERMINATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT.

IN THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT:

IN THE MATTER of the Labour and Industry Act 1953.

AND

IN THE MATTER of a Determination made by the Fire Fighters Board and dated the 8th day of October, 1954.

AND

IN THE MATTER of Appeals against certain provisions of the said Determination.

Before the Industrial Appeals Court (Judge Dethridge, K. H. Boykett, Esq., and J. V. Stout, Esq.).

Tuesday, the 21st day of December, 1954.

Having heard the abovementioned Appeals on the 9th and 10th days of December, 1954, and on this day this Court doth order and determine:---

- 1. That clause 15 (a) be deleted from the Determination;
- 2. That clause 16 be amended to read-
  - "Employee not to be required to clean clothing.—An Employee shall not be ordered to clean the clothing of any other person by a process ordinarily used in a laundry or dry cleaning establishment."
- 3. That this Determination come into force from the pay period commencing Friday, 24th December, 1954.
