DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Apprentices or Improvers-continued

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

Apprentices.

MALES.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 252s. per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 195s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.

MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 252s. per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 195s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
