DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

I, Henry Norman Jones, Secretary for Labour and Industry, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Labour and Industry Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1956.

WATCH CASES BOARD.

Clauses 2 and 3 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 33 of the 4th February, 1955, as amended shall be replaced by the following clauses:—

WAGES PER WEEK OF 40 HOURS

(a) Apprentices. Total Wage Payable-Within 20 Miles G.P.O., Melbourne; 10 Miles of G.P.O., Geelong; at Warrnambool; and within Mildura and Gippeland Districts. Basic Wage. Per Week. Apprentice commencing after the age of 17 years Four-year term 1st year 2nd year 3rd year 581 89 14 100 plus 22s.

An employee who is under 21 years of age on the expiration of his apprenticeship and thereafter works as a minor in the occupation to which he has been apprenticed shall be paid at not less than the adult rate prescribed for that classification.

The rates shall be calculated to the nearest 6d., any broken part of 6d. in the result not exceeding 3d. to be disregarded.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination, as amended, shall remain in force.
