Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE TEA PACKING BOARD.

Note.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons (other than persons subject to the Determination of the Grocers Board) employed either inside or outside a factory or work-room, in the process, trade, or business of preparing tea, coffee, cocoa, or chocolate for trade or sale, including blending, weighing, filling packets, wrapping, packing, or labelling", has made the following Determination, namely:—

That on the 23rd August, 1956, the Determination made on the 11th April, 1956, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 547 of the 15th June, 1956, shall be amended by deleting clauses 6 and 7 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:—

HOLIDAYS.

6. Employees shall be granted the following holidays without deduction of pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Union Picnic Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, and within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Labour and Industry Acts, Melbourne Cup Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays this provisions shall apply only to the the day so substituted.

Olympic Day, 22nd November, 1956 (within such area as may be proclaimed by Order in Council), shall be deemed to be included in the list of holidays herein prescribed. Provided that any employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday without reasonable excuse, shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday

SPECIAL RATES.

7. Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Queen's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, and within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Labour and Industry Acts, Melbourne Cup Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

Olympic Day, 22nd November, 1956 (within such area as may be proclaimed by Order in Council), shall be deemed to be included in the list of holidays herein prescribed.
