## AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE BISCUIT BOARD.

NOTES.—(a) This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

(b) On the 21st June, 1913, the powers of the Biscuit Board were extended to enable it to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person employed as storeman, packer, or sorter in connexion with the trade or business of making biscuits."

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person employed in making biscuits," has made the following Determination, namely :—

That on the 18th October, 1956, the Determination made on the 21st May, 1956, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 747 of the 14th August, 1956, shall be amended by adding the following new clause :—

### OLYMPIC GAMES HOLIDAY.

12A. In connexion with the holding of the Olympic Games in Victoria during the months of November and December, 1956, where a holiday or a half-holiday is proclaimed by Order in Council throughout any Municipality or part thereof, or within any defined area, such holiday or half-holiday shall, so far as such Municipality or part thereof, or such defined area is concerned be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in clause 12.

Provided that no employee shall be entitled to the conditions prescribed by this clause for more than the equivalent of one working day.
