*Labour and Industry Acts.*

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE ROAD PATROLMENS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies within the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons, or classes of persons (other than persons subject to the jurisdiction of any Wages Board heretofore appointed), employed by a club or association of users of motor vehicles which renders free roadside service to its members, and engaged at testing, replacing, repairing, or adjusting parts of motor vehicles," has made the following Determination namely:—

That, as from the 11th September, 1956, a new clause shall be inserted in the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 48 of the 4th February, 1956, as follows—

9A. Olympic Day, 22nd November, 1956 (within such area as may be proclaimed by Order in Council), shall be deemed to be included in the list of holidays herein prescribed in clause 9. Provided that any employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday without reasonable excuse, shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday.
