AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE BOARDING SCHOOL EMPLOYEES BOARD

Note.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State.

In accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed at domestic work in or in connexion with sub-primary, primary, or secondary boarding schools, has made the following Determination, namely:—

That, on the 28th August, 1956, the Determination made on the 14th December, 1953, and published in Government Gazette No. 166 of the 2nd April, 1954, as amended, shall be further amended by deleting clause 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:—

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

9. All employees (other than casual employees) shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction of pay, viz., New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day, Christmas Day and Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of these holidays, employees shall be entitled to the days so substituted.

Provided that if any employee works on any of such holidays or such holiday occurs on his or her rostered day off or during his or her period of annual leave or sick leave, he or she shall be given :---

- (a) within four weeks following the date on which such holiday occurred-

 - (i) one extra day's pay, or(ii) equal time off in lieu thereof, or

(b) one day shall be added to his or her annual leave.

Olympic Day, 22nd November, 1956 (within such area as may be proclaimed by Order in Council), shall be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in Clause 9 hereof. Provided that any employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday without reasonable excuse, shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday.
