One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

improvers. Males.

One male improver to every four or fraction of four male workers recoiving not less than the minimum wage.

Females.

One female improver to every four or traction of four fomale workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
