DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

 - (v) Improvers shall not be employed to displace men.
 - The Board has determined that no person shall be taken as an apprentice.
