DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Improvers.

One improver to every adult male worker.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that, to the weekly earnings of each piece-worker, shall be added the sum of one hundred and sixty-three shillings. Where less than 40 hours is worked in any week by any piece-worker, a proportionate amount of such sum of one hundred and sixty-three shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
