One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 240s. 3d. per week of 40

One male improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 male workers receiving not less than 320s. per week of 40 hours.

One female improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 female workers receiving not less than 240s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

EGG PULPING OR DRYING SECTION.

Apprentices.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 320s. per week of 40 hours.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 240s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.

One male improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 male workers receiving not less than 320s, per week of 40 hours.

One female improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 female workers receiving not less than 240s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

ALL OTHER SECTIONS.

Apprentices.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 321s, per week of 40 hours.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 240s, 3d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.

One male improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 male workers receiving not less than 321s. per week of 40 hours.

One female improver to every 25 or fraction of 25 female workers receiving not less than 240s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.
