Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE WATCH CASES BOARD.

Note.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

I N accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the trade of manufacturing or preparing watch cases" has made the following Determination, namely:—

- 1. That as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1956, the Determination made on the 1st December, 1954, and published in Government Gazette No. 33 of the 4th February, 1955, shall be amended by:—
