The total wage shall be calculated to the nearest sixpence, any broken part of sixpence in the result not exceeding three pence to be disregarded.

(b) The minimum rate payable to a junior female of any age or a junior male of eighteen years or more each with less than six months' experience under this Determination shall, until be or she has had six months' experience, be 10 per cent, less than the amount represented by the percentage of the basic wage hereby prescribed for a junior employee of his or her age.

Prohibited Occupations.

(c) Junior employees shall not be employed:—
if under the age of 16 years—
on oil or gas burners or fires used for heating of small articles;
using electric are or oxy acetylene blow pipe.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 3, of the said Determination shall remain in force,
