Note.—The rates prescribed for improvers shall apply only to such employees as are under 21 years of age, or who, being over 21 years of age, are the holders of improvers' licences.

PROPORTION.

One improver to each person of the same sex receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination for this Section shall remain in force.
