Improvers.

One male improver to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 284s. per week.

One female improver to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 206s, per week.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
