Apprentices.	
MALES.	
One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 297s, per week.	
FEMALES.	
One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 231s. per week.	
Improvers.	
MALES.	
One male improver to every two or fraction of two workers receiving not ess than 297s, per week.	
FRMALES.	
One female improver to every two or fraction of two workers receiving not less than 231s, per week.	

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
