#### DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

#### DISPENSARIES BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 10th August, 1955, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in September, 1955, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

### Proportion (IN ANY PLACE).

- (a) Unregistered Assistants.
  - One unregistered assistant to every three or fraction of three Pharmaceutical Chemists receiving not less than £20 13s. 6d. per week.
- (b) Apprentices.
  One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers recoiving not less than 413s. 6d. per week.
- (c) Juvenile Workers.
  - One juvenile worker (i.e., a shop assistant not engaged in dispensing or compounding medicines, drugs or medicinal preparations, and who is under the age of 21 years) may be employed in any dispensary.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
