*Labour and Industry Acts.*

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE PAINT AND COLOUR BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

In accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board which since the 4th February, 1936, has had the power to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons—

(a) employed in the trade of preparing any kind of paint, varnish, enamel or colour, either wet or dry;

(b) employed in manufacturing titanium white or white lead,  
has made the following Determination, namely:—

That as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in March, 1956, the Determination made on the 25th May, 1955, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 600 of the 15th August, 1955, shall be amended by inserting after clause 2 the following clause.

ADDITIONAL PAYMENT.

2A. Employees selecting, handling, weighing and/or distributing pigments or resins shall be paid an additional amount at the rate of 7s. 6d. per week as a disability allowance.
