REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1946*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 6th May, 1956, as follows:—

SEVENTH SCHEDULE—*continued.*

Note.—When an officer is required to reside at the institution, a charge of £153 a year will be made (except where otherwise specified in these Regulations) for quarters and rations.

All Nurses designated as such, Ward Assistants (Female), Housekeepers, Cooks, and Laundresses will be provided with uniforms.

Male Nurses and Ward Assistants (Male) will be provided with one tunic and two pairs of trousers annually.

Deductions from Salaries of Officers Residing in Separate Quarters in the Reserves of the Various Mental Institutions.

Deductions will be made from the salaries of these officers in accordance with the Schedule hereunder :—

Principal and Head Nurses and Housekeepers will be charged £153 a year for rations and allowances other than quarters.

Officers who are not supplied with quarters will be charged £71 a year for meals supplied in an institution, provided that where officers other than nursing staff are supplied with midday meals only, the charge will be 2/6 a meal.
