DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Apprentices.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three persons receiving not less than £13 15 0 per week

Improvers.

One improver to one person receiving not less than £13 15s. 0d. per week, two improvers to two or three such persons, thereafter two additional improvers to every three additional such persons.
