COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA—STATE OF VICTORIA.

WHEREAS, by a Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* of the State of Victoria on the third day of February, 1956, new Electoral Districts for the State of Victoria were proclaimed; and whereas the said Districts and the Commonwealth Electoral Divisions for the said State have been divided into Subdivisions and the boundaries of several Subdivisions have been altered; and whereas consequently the enrolment of certain electors has become changed to a Subdivision or District differing in name from the Subdivision or District for which they were previously enrolled; notice is hereby given that the electors who immediately heretofore were enrolled for the Subdivisions and Districts set out in Part I. of the Schedule hereto are now respectively enrolled for the Subdivisions and Districts set out in Part II. of the said Schedule opposite the names of the first-mentioned Subdivisions and Districts.
