## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Clause 2 of the Determination for this Section published in Government Gazette No. 135 of the 26th March, 1954, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

Males.  One male improver to each male person receiving not less than the minimum wage;  Females. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination for this Section shall remain in force.
