Other Employees.

Wages per Week of 40 Hours.

Males. Senior salesman, i.e., a person in immediate control of two or more employees one of whom shall be 21 years of age or over, notwithstanding such senior salesman may be under the orders of a superior who does not devote his whole time to the management of the Salesmen and all employees assisting in sales

Females.

Females employed in Milinery, Mantles, Corsets, Under-clothing, Hosiery, Haberdashery, Ribbon, Glove, or Lace Departments— Senior saleswoman, i.e., a person in immediate
