DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Where less than forty hours is worked in any week by any piece-worker, a proportionate amount of such sum of 150/- shall be added in lieu thereof.
