Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE PLASTER OF PARIS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts the Plaster of Paris Board has made the following Amending Determination namely—

That as from the 7th November, 1956, the Determination made on the 14th December, 1954, and in force as from the first pay period to commence on or after the 29th December, 1954, as published in *Government Gazette* No. 24 on the 28th January, 1955, shall be amended as follows:—

By inserting a new clause 11A to read—

OLYMPIC GAMES HOLIDAY.

11A. In connexion with the holding of the Olympic Games in Victoria during the months of November and December, 1956, where a holiday or half-holiday is proclaimed by Order-in-Council throughout any Municipality or part thereof, or within any defined area, such holiday or half-holiday shall, so far as such Municipality or part thereof or such defined area is concerned be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in clause 11.

Provided that no employee shall be entitled to the conditions prescribed by this clause for more than the equivalent of one working day.

Provided further that an employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday or half-holiday without reasonable excuse shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday or half-holiday.
