Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Musical Instruments Board has made the following amending Determination, namely:—

That, on the 14th November, 1956, the Determination made on the 20th May, 1956, and in force on the 1st June, 1956, shall be amended by adding the following new clause:—

OLYMPIC GAMES HOLIDAY.

23A. In connexion with the holding of the Olympic Games in Victoria, during the months of November, and December, 1956, where a holiday or half-holiday is proclaimed by Order in Council throughout any Municipality or part thereof, or within any defined area, such holiday or half-holiday shall, so far as such Municipality or part thereof, or such defined area is concerned be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in clause 23.

Provided that no employee shall be entitled to the conditions prescribed by this clause for more than the equivalent of one working day.

Provided further that an employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday or half-holiday without reasonable excuse shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday or half-holiday.
