PROCLAMATION OF PROHIBITED PERIOD.

### PROCLAMATION.

PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Forests Act 1958, I the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation proclaim the period commencing at midnight between the fourth and fifth days of November. One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and ending at midnight between the fifteenth and sixteenth days of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty, to be the prohibited period in respect to any fire protected area other than a State forest or national park in the State of Victoria situated in such municipalities as are specified in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE.

The Shires of Glenelg, Kowree, Minhamite, Portland.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this Fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and in the eighth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
