ENTERTAINMENTS TAX (REDUCTION) ACT 1959. DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the eighth year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., intituled the Entertainments Tax (Reduction) Act 1959, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday, the ninth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, as the day upon which the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and in the eighth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
