# REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act* 1958, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 21st February, 1960, as follows:—
