## REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 21st February, 1960, as follows:—

The First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, and Seventh Schedules to these Regulations are revoked and the following Schedules substituted therefor:—
