*Country Fire Authority Act 1958.*VARIATION OF SUMMER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED PARTS  
OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF VICTORIA.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958* it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by Declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the summer period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the summer period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

And whereas by the said section it is further enacted that any Declaration so published may be revoked, amended or varied by a subsequent Declaration so published:

And whereas by Declarations issued on the twenty-sixth day of November, 1962, the fourth day of December, 1962, and the eleventh day of December, 1962, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the twenty-eighth day of November, 1962, the fifth day of December, 1962, and the twelfth day of December, 1962, respectively different summer periods expiring on the fifteenth day of April, 1963, and the thirtieth day of April, 1963, were declared in respect of different parts of the country area of Victoria, including the parts of the said country area specified in the Schedule hereto:

And whereas it is deemed expedient that the aforesaid Declarations should be varied in the manner hereinafter described:

And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do by this my Declaration vary the aforesaid Declarations by declaring that the summer period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria specified in the Schedule hereto shall end at midnight on the first day of March, 1963.

## SCHEDULE.

Those portions of the sixth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the City of Colac and the Town of Camperdown;

those portions of the Seventeenth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of Dimboola, Dunmunkle, Kaniva, Lowan and Warracknabeal and those portions of the Shires of Arapiles and Wimmera respectively which lie in a northerly direction from the under-mentioned boundaries, that is to say:—

- (a) *Shire of Arapiles*.—Commencing at the intersection of the Rifle Butts-road and with the McKenzie River; thence generally westerly and north-westerly along the aforementioned road and the Clear Lake-Tooen-Duffholme road to its intersection with the western boundary of the municipal district;

(b) *Shire of Wimmera*.—Commencing at the intersection of the Wimmera River with the Rocklands-Lubeck Channel on the eastern boundary of the municipal district; thence generally in a westerly and south-westerly direction along the aforementioned channel to its intersection with the McKenzie River on the western boundary of the municipal district;

those portions of the Eighteenth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Borough of Swan Hill and the Shire of Karkaroc and those portions of the Shire of Swan Hill which lie south from the under-mentioned boundary, that is to say:—Commencing at the south-western angle of Crown allotment 31, no section, Parish of Kulwin; thence easterly by a road and a line to a point on the west bank of the River Murray distant approximately 5,500 links easterly from the most eastern angle of Crown allotment 79, no section, Parish of Piangil;

those portions of the Twentieth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of Birchip, Charlton, Cohuna, Donald, Gordon, Kerang and Wycheproof;

those portions of the Twenty-second Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of Cobram and Tungamah; and

those portions of the Twenty-third Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of Rutherglen and Yarrawonga and those portions of the Shire of Wangaratta defined in the First Schedule to this Declaration.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE.

Commencing at a point on the eastern or right-hand bank of the Ovens River at its junction with the south side of the Murray Valley Highway on frontage abutting allotments Nos. 1 and A1, Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly bounded by the southern side of Murray Valley Highway to the north-east corner of allotment 5 of said parish; thence southerly along eastern boundary of allotments 5 and 5A to the south-east corner of allotment 5A; thence crossing Government road easterly; thence bearing easterly along northern boundary of allotments 8A, 8B, 9A and 9 to north-east corner of allotment 9; thence easterly across Government road to the eastern boundary of Parish of Boorhaman; thence southerly along eastern side of boundary road with Rutherglen Shire to the south-west corner of allotment 32 of said Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly along northern side of boundary road with Rutherglen Shire to the south-eastern corner of allotment No. 47, Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly across Government road to south-west corner of allotment 2B, Parish of Bontherambo; thence easterly along the northern side of boundary road to south-east corner of allotment 26A of said Parish of Bontherambo at its junction with Parish of Chiltern West at the western boundary of allotment B6, section XI., of the said Parish of Chiltern West; thence easterly to a point on the northern side of boundary road situated 999 links south of west from the eastern corner of allotment E, section XI., Parish of Chiltern West; thence following the north-western boundary of the North-Eastern Railway Reserve in a south-westerly direction through the Parish of Chiltern West, Bontherambo, Carragarmungee and Wangaratta North to its junction with the north-eastern or right-hand bank of the Reidy Creek in the Shire of Wangaratta; thence following the said right-hand or eastern bank of Reidy Creek to its junction with the right-hand or eastern bank of the Ovens River; thence following the eastern bank of the Ovens River to the point of commencement.
