PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the Public Service Act 1958, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Half-Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

Public Half-Holiday from the Hour of Eleven o'clock a.m.:—

*SATURDAY, THE 2ND MARCH, 1963, throughout the Shire of Warragul.

Public Half-Holiday from the Hour of Twelve o'clock noon:---

MONDAY, THE 25TH MARCH, 1963, throughout the Shire of Ballan. * Agricultural Show.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-seventh day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and in the twelfth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
