Senate Elections Act 1958

WHEREAS on the 9th day of November, 1964, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria issued a Writ for the Election of five Senators for the State of Victoria to serve in the Senate of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia from and after the 1st day of July, 1965:

And whereas the Poll for the said election was held on the 5th day of December, 1964:

And whereas the 23rd January, 1965, was fixed as the day on or before which the said Writ shall be returned to His Excellency:

And whereas it has been made to appear to His Excellency that the time fixed for the return of the said Writ should be extended for a period of two months, that is until the 22nd March, 1965:

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the *Senate Elections Act 1958*, No. 6365, has this day fixed the 22nd day of March, 1965, as the day on or before which the said Writ shall be returned to His Excellency.
