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Country Fire Authority Act 1958.

VARIATION OF SUMMER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF VICTORIA.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958* it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the summer period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the summer period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

And whereas by the said section it is further enacted that any declaration so published may be revoked, amended or varied by a subsequent declaration so published:

And whereas by declarations issued on the 3rd day of December, 1963, the 10th day of December, 1963 and the 17th day of December, 1963, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 4th day of December, 1963, the 11th day of December, 1963, and the 18th day of December, 1963, respectively, different summer periods expiring on the 30th day of April, 1964, were declared in respect of different parts of the country area of Victoria, including the parts of the said country area specified in the Schedule hereto:

And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do by this my declaration vary the aforesaid declarations by declaring that the summer period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria specified in the Schedule hereto shall end at midnight on the 10th day of April, 1964.

SCHEDULE.

The Tenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Cities of Sale and Traralgon and the Shires of Alberton, Avon, Maffra, Morwell, Rosedale and Traralgon;

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the Eleventh Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Bairnsdale, Omeo, Orbost and Tambo;

the Twelfth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Alexandra and Yea;

the Fourteenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Bacchus Marsh, Broadford, Bulla, Gisborne, Kilmore, Melton, Newham and Woodend and Romsey and those portions of the municipal districts of the Cities of Broadmeadows, Sunshine and Keilor and the Shire of Whittlesea not included in the Metropolitan Fire District;

the Twenty-second Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Shepparton, the Boroughs of Echuca and Kyabram and the Shires of Cobram, Deakin, Euroa, Goulburn, Mclvor, Nathalia, Numurkah, Pyalong, Rodney, Seymour, Shepparton, Tungamah, Violet Town and Waranga;

the Twenty-fourth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Beechworth, Bright, Chiltern, Myrtleford, Towong, Upper Murray, Wodonga and Yackandandah;

those portions of the Fourth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of Glenelg and Wannon;

those portions of the Sixth Fire Control Region comprised by those portions of the municipal district of the Shire of Heytesbury comprised by the Parishes of Carpendeit and Coradjil and those portions of the municipal district of the Shire of Otway not contained in the Apollo Bay Urban Fire District as defined herewith:—the Townships of Krambruk and Marengo and Parish of Krambruk, County of Polwarth; commencing at a point on the foreshore of Bass Strait, Parish of Krambruk, in line with the north boundary of allotment B, no section; bounded thence by a line and said allotment B bearing west to the south-east angle of allotment 22 of section 1; thence by said allotment 22 bearing west and north-westerly to the south-west angle thereof; thence by allotment 21 bearing southerly to the south-west angle thereof; thence by allotments 18, a line, and 17, bearing west to the north-west angle of the last-mentioned

allotment; thence by said allotment 17 and allotments 2, a line, and 3, bearing south to the south-west angle of the last-mentioned allotment; thence by said allotment 3, bearing east to the south-east angle thereof; thence by allotment 5 bearing south to the south-west angle thereof; thence by a line bearing south-easterly to the north-east angle of allotment 8A of section 2A; thence by that allotment bearing southerly to the reserve for watering purposes; thence by that reserve bearing easterly to the west boundary of the Township of Marengo; thence by that boundary bearing southerly to a point due west of Cape Marengo (Point Hayley), Parish of Krambruk; thence by a line bearing east to Cape Marengo aforesaid; and thence by the foreshore along Bass Strait aforesaid bearing generally northerly to the point of commencement;

those portions of the Fifteenth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the City of Maryborough, the Boroughs of Clunes and Daylesford and the Shires of Creswick, Glenlyon, Kyneton, Newstead, Talbot and Tullaroop;

those portions of the Sixteenth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Town of Stawell and the Shires of Avoca and Stawell;

those portions of the Twenty-third Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the City of Wangaratta, the Borough of Benalla, the Shires of Benalla, Mansfield and Oxley and those portions of the municipal district of the Shire of Wangaratta not contained in the boundaries defined herewith:—

Commencing at a point on the eastern or right hand bank of the Ovens River at its junction with the South side of the Murray Valley Highway on frontage abutting allotment Nos. 1 and A1, Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly bounded by the southern side of Murray Valley Highway to the north-east corner of allotment 5 of said Parish;

thence southerly along eastern boundary of allotments 5 and 5A to the south-east corner of allotment 5A; thence crossing Government-road easterly; thence bearing easterly along northern boundary of allotments 8A, 8B, 9A and 9 to the north-east corner of allotment 9; thence easterly across Government-road to the eastern boundary of Parish of Boorhaman; thence southerly along eastern side of Boundary-road with Rutherglen Shire to the south-west corner of allotment 32 of said Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly along northern side of Boundary-road with Rutherglen Shire to the south-eastern corner of allotment No. 47, Parish of Boorhaman; thence easterly across Government-road to south-west corner of allotment 2a, Parish of Bontherambo; thence easterly along the northern side of Boundary-road to the south-east corner of allotment 26A of said Parish of Bontherambo at its junction with Parish of Chiltern West at the western boundary of allotment B6, section X1 of said Parish of Chiltern West; thence easterly to a point on the northern side of Boundary-road situated 999 links south of west from the eastern corner of allotment E, section X1, Parish of Chiltern West; thence following the north-western boundary of the north-eastern railway reserve in a south-westerly direction through the Parish of Chiltern West, Bontherambo, Carraragarmungee and Wangaratta North to its junction with the north-eastern or right hand bank of the Reidy Creek in the Shire of Wangaratta; thence following the said right hand or eastern bank of Reidy Creek to its junction with the right hand or eastern bank of Ovens River; thence following the eastern bank of the Ovens River to the point of commencement.
