CLOSING OF ROADS AND EXTINGUISHMENT OF EASEMENTS—SHIRE OF MILDURA.

MARKETING OF PRIMARY PRODUCTS ACT 1958 (No. 6304).

APPOINTMENT OF TOBACCO LEAF MARKETING BOARD.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation made on the 20th day of December, 1963, under the provisions of section 7 of the Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958 (No. 6304), the Governor in Council declared that tobacco leaf shall be a commodity under and for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas by a Proclamation made on the 10th day of March, 1964, under the provisions of section 7 of the said Act, the Governor in Council declared that a marketing Board shall be constituted in relation to the said commodity and that the provisions of the said Act shall apply to such commodity: And whereas it is provided by section 8 of the said Act that the Governor in Council after the application of the said Act to a commodity may by Order appoint a marketing Board in relation to the commodity: And whereas it is further provided by the said section that the Board shall consist of the number of members specified in that behalf in a petition presented to the Governor in Council pursuant to section 7 of the said Act and of the members thereof one shall be a person appointed by the Governor in Council and the others shall be persons elected by the producers of the commodity in accordance with the said Act: And whereas it is provided by section 9 of the said Act that every Board constituted under the said Act shall be a body corporate by the name assigned to it by the Governor in Council: And whereas it is further provided by section 11 of the said Act that a person appointed or elected as a member of a Board shall hold office for the period (not exceeding two years) for which he is appointed: And

whereas the number of members specified in the petition presented to the Governor in Council pursuant to the said Act in relation to tobacco leaf was five: And

Appoint a Marketing Board in relation to tobacco leaf and assign to such Board the name of "The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board."

2. Appoint-

WALTER JAMES BARCLAY McDonald as a member of The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board to hold office for a period of two years.

3. Declare that The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board shall consist of five members, namely—

HUGHIE HAMILTON KNEEBONE,
NORMAN FREDRICK SMITH, and
WALTER JAMES BARCLAY MCDONALD.

4. Appoint the said-

William Rudolph Selzer,
Hughie Hamilton Kneebone, and
Norman Fredrick Smith
to hold office as members of The Tobacco Leaf
Marketing Board for a period of two years.

And the Honorable Gilbert Lawrence Chandler, Her Majesty's Minister of Agriculture for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
