REWARD

NOTICE is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons guilty of one or more of the following offences :—

- (a) An unlawful assault on Miss Gertrude Violet Dicker near the Armadale Railway Station on 7th September, 1963, at about 8 p.m.
- (b) The unlawful wounding of Mrs. Louis Naphine at her home in Kooyong-road, Toorak, when a handbag and wallet was stolen, on 4th October, 1963, at about 9.30 p.m.
- (c) An unlawful assault on Miss Noelle Margaret Newton in Myvor-street, Toorak, when her handbag containing money was stolen, on 7th November, 1963, at about 8.50 p.m.
- (d) An unlawful assault on Miss Dawn Rosalie Turner at the front door of her home in Hawksburn-road, South Yarra, when her handbag containing money was stolen, on 13th November, 1963, at about 9.45 p.m.

CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the apprehension and conviction of a person or persons guilty of any of the four offences abovementioned will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding in the aggregate £500 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
