## REWARD

NOTICE is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons guilty of one or more of the following crimes:—

- (a) The killing of Vincenzo Angilletta at Fairfield on the 4th April, 1963.
- (b) The killing of Vincent Muratore at Hampton on the 16th January, 1964.
- (c) The wounding of Domenico Demarte at North Melbourne on the 26th November, 1963.

### CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the apprehension and conviction of a person or persons guilty of any of the three crimes abovementioned will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding in the aggregate £5,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
