DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION OF ACT.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the second, intituled the *Labour and Industry (Amendment) Act 1965*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix the ninth day of June, 1965 as the day upon which all of the provisions of the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this ninth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, and in the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

## PROCLAMATION
