STATE RIVERS AND WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the ninth day of June, 1965.

PRESENT:

DRYSDALE URBAN DISTRICT—AREA OF DISTRICT INCREASED.

UNDER the powers conferred by the Water Act 1958 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf. His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, on the recommendation of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission, doth hereby declare, order, and direct as follows:-

That the area of the Drysdale Urban District be increased by adding thereto the land set out and described in the Schedule hereto and as on and from the 15th day of June, 1965, the area of such District shall be deemed to be so increased.

SCHEDULE.

1. Commencing at a point on the southern shore of Port Phillip Bay distant 5 chains westerly from and at right angles to a northerly production of the eastern boundary of allotment 58, Parish of Bellarine, County of Grant; thence southerly by a line parallel to Shore Line Drive to the southern boundary of the land in lodged plan of subdivision No. 54837; thence westerly by the southern boundary of the land in that subdivision and generally north-westerly by the south-western boundaries of the

said subdivision and the land in lodged plan of subdivision No. 54836 to the north-western angle of lot 1925 on the last-mentioned plan of subdivision; thence north by a line to the southern shore of Port Phillip Bay; thence generally easterly by that shore to the point of commencement.

Commencing at a point in the eastern boundary of lot 3053 on lodged plan of subdivision No. 58854, distant 5 chains northerly from and at right angles to the southern boundary of Crown allotment 11, Parish of Bellarine, County of Grant; thence westerly by a line parallel to that allotment boundary to a point distant 5 chains easterly from the western boundary of allotment 10; thence northerly by a line parallel to Springs-road to the south-western boundary of allotment 12; thence south-easterly by that allotment boundary to the south-eastern angle of lot 2597 on lodged plan of subdivision No. 58769; thence westerly by the southern boundaries of said lot 2597, lots 2596, 2595, 2594, 2593, 2592, 2591, and 2552 on that plan of subdivision and a line connecting those boundaries to a point in line with the eastern boundary of lot 2801 on lodged plan of subdivision No. 58770; thence south-resterly by the south-eastern boundary of the land in lodged plan of subdivision No. 58771 to the south-eastern angle of lot 2927 on that plan of subdivision; hence easterly and southerly by the northern and eastern boundaries of the land in lodged plan of subdivision No. 58871 to the south-eastern angle of lot 2927 on that plan of subdivision No. 58854 to the point of commencement. 58854 to the point of commencement.

SHIRE OF NURMURKAH WATERWORKS TRUST—EXTENT OF DISTRICT DIMINISHED—WUNGHNU URBAN DISTRICT—PORTIONS EXCISED.

UNDER the powers conferred by the Water Act 1958 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf. His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, doth hereby declare, order, and direct as follows:—

Firstly, that the extent of the Waterworks District of the Shire of Numurkah Waterworks Trust be diminished by excising therefrom the portions of the same set out and described in the Schedule hereto, which portions as from the 15th day of June, 1965, shall be deemed to be excised accordingly and secondly, that there shall be excised from the Wunghnu Urban District that portion of the same set out in the said Schedule, which portions as from the 15th day of June, 1965, shall be deemed to be excised accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

Portion 1. Commencing at the south-eastern angle of allotment 22, section D, Parish of Mundoona, County of Moira; thence easterly by the northern boundary of a Government road to a point in line with the western boundary of allotment 1, section 19, Township of Wunghnu; thence southerly by a line and the western boundary of said allotment 1 and easterly by the southern boundary of that allotment to the south-eastern angle thereof; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of allotment 6 and a line in continuation thereof to the right bank of the Broken Creek; thence north-westerly and generally south-westerly by that creek bank to the western boundary of a road forming the western boundary of the Township of Wunghnu; thence northerly by the said road boundary to the point of commencement.

Portion 2. The whole of allotments 3 and 4, section 18, Township of Wunghnu, Parish of Drumanure.

The lands set out and described in the foregoing Schedule are shown on a plan approved by the Governor in Council, and deposited in the Office of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission, Melbourne.—(Corres. No. 62 (1001). 63/1001.)
