ABORIGINES (AMENDMENT) ACT 1965, No. 7267.

Date of Coming into Operation.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria, passed in the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., intituled the Aborigines (Amendment) Act 1965, No. 7267, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, as the day on which the said Aborigines (Amendment) Act 1965, No. 7267, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-ninth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, and in the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
