REGULATIONS.—PART IV.—SALARIES AND INCREMENTS.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 1st August, 1965, as follows:—

THE Public Service Board in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Public Service Act 1958, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 1st August, 1965, as follows:—
