The Acting Premier, with feelings of profound regret, announces to the public the death, on Tuesday, the 10th August, 1965, at Melbourne, of the Honourable Sir Gordon Stewart McArthur, M.L.C., President of the Legislative Council.

A Service will be held at Toorak Presbyterian Church on Thursday, the 12th August, 1965, commencing at 10.15 a.m.

At the conclusion of the Service, the State Funeral will proceed from the church via Toorak-road, Kingsway, King-street and Lonsdale-street to Spencer-street Railway Station and thence by train to Camperdown. At 2.20 p.m. the funeral will proceed from the Camperdown Railway Station via Pike-street, Manifold-street and the Princes Highway to the Camperdown General Cemetery.
