Country Fire Authority Act 1958.

VARIATION OF SUMMER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF
SPECIFIED PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF
VICTORIA.

WHEREAS on the 16th day of March, 1966, the Chief Secretary issued a declaration pursuant to the provisions of section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958* varying the summer period in respect of certain parts of the country area of Victoria by declaring that the summer period in respect of the areas concerned should end at midnight on the 18th March, 1966, and such declaration was published in the *Government Gazette* of the 16th March, 1966:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the said section, do by this my declaration amend the aforesaid declaration by substituting for the following words in Schedule B—

“and those portions of the Shire of Wangaratta bounded on the west by the Ovens River, the Reedy Creek and on the east by the north Eastern Railway Line.”

the following words:—

“and those portions of the municipal district of the Shire of Wangaratta bounded on the east by the Ovens River, the Reedy Creek and on the south-west by the North Eastern Railway Line.”
