REGULATIONS.—PART IV.—SALARIES AND INCREMENTS.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 27th March, 1966, as follows:—
