ROADS DISCONTINUED—CITY OF MELBOURNE.

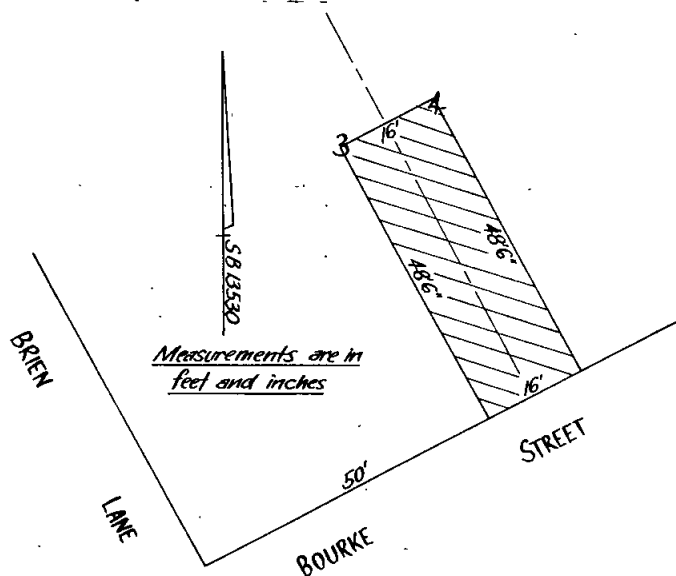
WHEREAS it is provided in section 528 (2) of the Local Government Act, as amended, that where a road (whether or not a public highway but not being a road set out on land of the Crown) or any part thereof is not required for

public use the Governor in Council on the request of the Council of the municipality in which such road is situated, made not less than one month after publishing in a newspaper generally circulating in the district and posting to the registered proprietor (if any) of the land and any person known to have an interest in the land notice of intention to make such request may by Order published in the *Government Gazette* direct that such road or part shall be discontinued and thereupon such road or part shall be discontinued accordingly:

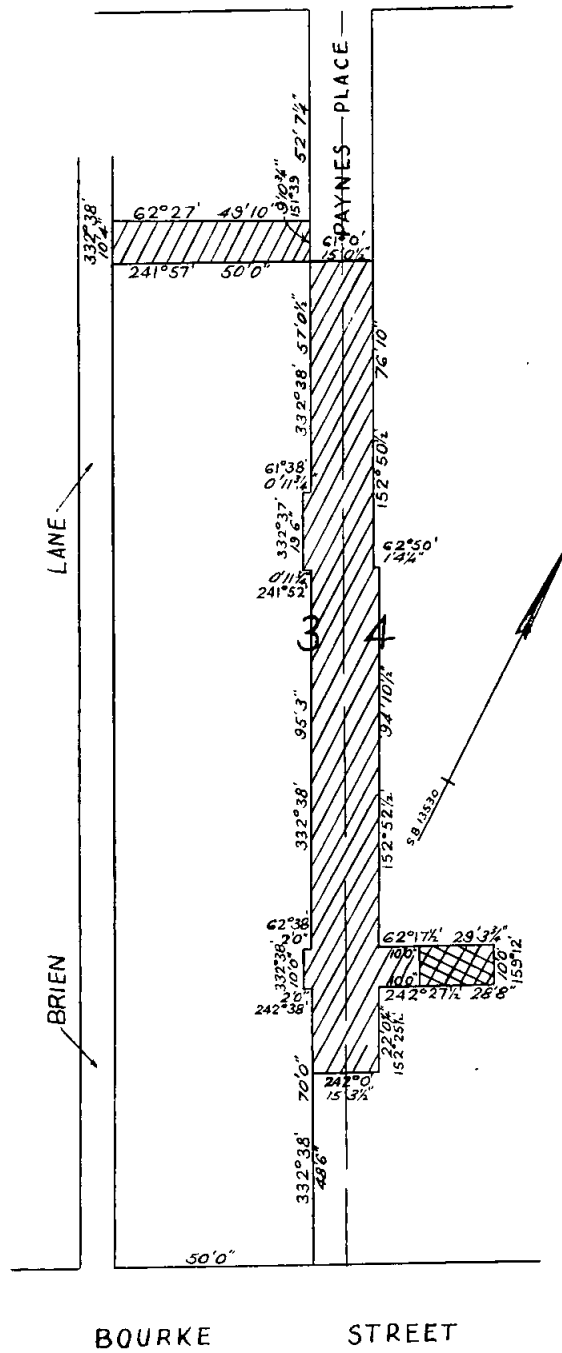
And whereas the Council of the City of Melbourne has requested that the Governor in Council direct that portions of Paynes-place, Croft-alley, and an unnamed road off Paynes-place, Melbourne, be discontinued and not less than one month previously has published in a newspaper generally circulating in the district and posted to the registered proprietors of the lands in the roads and to all persons known to have an interest in the said roads notice of intention to make such request.

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, hereby directs:

- (a) that the said roads which are shown by hachure and cross-hachure on the two plans hereunder, shall be discontinued;
- (b) that notwithstanding such discontinuance the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works shall continue to have and possess the same right title power authority or interest in or in relation to the land which is shown by cross-hachure on one of the said plans as it had or possessed prior to such discontinuance with respect to or in connexion with any sewers or drains laid or erected in on or over such land for the purpose of sewerage or drainage;
- (c) that subject to any such right title power authority or interest, the land in the said roads may be sold by the Council of the City of Melbourne by agreement.
