REGULATIONS.—PART IV.—SALARIES AND INCREMENTS.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 26th February, 1967 as follows :—

The First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, and Seventh Schedules to these Regulations are revoked and the following Schedules substituted therefor :—

Public Service Act 1958.

REGULATIONS UNDER THE PUBLIC SERVICE ACT.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 26th February, 1967, as follows:—

PART II.—APPOINTMENTS TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE.

DIVISION III.—PROFESSIONAL DIVISION.

Regulation 22.

This Regulation is revoked and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

“22. Any candidate for appointment to a position of Draughtsman, Class ‘D-1’, Library Officer, Class ‘LR-1’ or Professional Officer (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science), Class ‘OP-1’ shall be required to enter for a competitive examination as may be from time to time prescribed.”

Regulation 23.

The words “Draughtsman, Class ‘E’” are deleted and the words “Draughtsman, Class ‘D-1’” are substituted in lieu thereof.

Regulation 24.

In clause (a) of sub-regulation (1), the words “Library Officer, Class ‘LR-1’” are substituted for the words “Librarian, Class ‘E’”.

In clause (b) of sub-regulation (1), the words “Professional Officer (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science), Class ‘OP-1’, Professional Division” are substituted for the words “Assistant, Class ‘E’, Professional Division, Institute of Applied Science”.

- (b) he holds a Degree of the University of Melbourne or an appropriate degree of any University approved by the Board, provided that no graduate shall be promoted or transferred to the office of Library Officer, Class 'LR-5' unless he has also passed the first three subjects of the Registration Examination."
