DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. intituled the *Motor Car (Hours of Driving) Act 1964*, No. 7234, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday, the fifteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, as the day on which the said *Motor Car (Hours of Driving) Act 1964*, No. 7234, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this tenth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven and in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

COUNTRY FIRE AUTHORITY ACT 1958.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the
tenth day of May, 1967.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria.

CONSENT TO BORROWING TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS BY THE COUNTRY FIRE AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS by section 82 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*, it is enacted that the Country Fire Authority, with the consent of the Governor in Council may from time to time, borrow such moneys as it deems necessary in order to enable it to carry out and perform the powers, authorities and duties vested in or conferred or imposed upon it by the said Act:

And whereas the Country Fire Authority deems it necessary to borrow the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars for the purposes aforesaid:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the said section 82 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958* and all other powers him thereunder enabling, doth by this order consent to the borrowing by the Country Fire Authority of the sum of \$25,000 (Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars) for a period of thirty (30) years, to be liquidated by half-yearly repayments on the principal sum, with interest at the rate of Five and Seven-Eighths (\$5.875) per centum per annum.

And the Honorable Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
