Date of Coming into Operation.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, intituled the Port Phillip Authority Act 1966 (No. 7498), it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation by the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette: Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday the seventh day of September One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven as the day upon which the Port Phillip Authority Act 1967 (No. 7498) shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fifth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven and in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
